

Horticultural Show Rules

1. The competition is open to the residents and near neighbours of Throwleigh and Gidleigh parishes. The Show Secretary reserves the right to refuse entry on the basis of geography of residence.
2. The judges' decisions are final, and the right to withhold an award is reserved.
3. No entries can be accepted on the day of the show without an entry form having been submitted **by 5.00pm on TUESDAY the 13th August 2019**, either in the posting box in the Church porch, OR with Mike Duffy at Pease Close, Throwleigh, OR with Julia Sanchez, 2 Higher Haye, Wonson .
4. In the Vegetable and Flower sections, the entries must have been grown in the exhibitor's own garden or greenhouse, Class 11 Flower Arrangement excepted.
5. Bread – Class 21 – must be hand made, not by bread making machine.
6. Only one entry is allowed per exhibitor per class.
7. Joint entries by two or more people are not permitted.
8. Entrants to the Junior section, classes 22 – 24, must be under fourteen on the day of the Show.
9. There are no entry fees.
10. First prizes are awarded for all classes in the Junior section, and the junior section of the Photographic competition.
11. Cups are awarded as follows:
 - a. Fox-Pitt Perpetual Trophy for the highest aggregate points gained in the Vegetable section
 - b. Booth Trophy for the highest aggregate points in the Flowers section
 - c. Perpetual Rose Bowl for the highest points aggregated in classes 14 – 19
 - d. Croxford Memorial Trophy for Class 21 hand made bread
 - e. Perpetual Junior Trophy for the highest points aggregated in the Junior section
 - f. The Throwleigh Archive Tankard for the winner of the adult section of Class 25.
