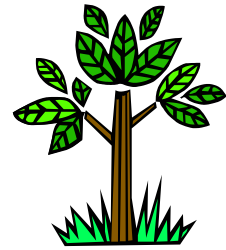


THROWLEIGH VILLAGE HALL
